Item 1 Address: 1301 Lougheed Highway (Real Canadian Superstore)

The intent of **Bylaw No. 5347, 2023** is to amend *City of Coquitlam Zoning Bylaw No. 3000, 1996* to add <u>1301</u> <u>Lougheed Highway</u> to the Permitted Locations for a Grocery Store with Wine on the Shelf – *Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 5347, 2023*.

If approved, the application would facilitate the sale of wine (including cider, mead, and sake) on grocery store shelves at the 1301 Lougheed Highway (Real Canadian Superstore).

Item 2 Address: 1184 Inlet Street

The intent of **Bylaw No. 5351, 2023** is to amend *City of Coquitlam Zoning Bylaw No. 3000, 1996* to rezone portions of the subject property as outlined in <u>black on the map marked Schedule 'A' to Bylaw No. 5351, 2023</u> from RM-1 Two-Storey Low Density Apartment Residential to RM-3 Multi-Storey Medium Density Apartment Residential – *Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 5351, 2023*.

If approved, the application would facilitate the creation of two six-storey market rental apartment buildings with 197 units.

Item 3 Text Amendment: Zoning Bylaw Housekeeping Text Amendments - Stage 1

The intent of **Bylaw No. 5345, 2023** is to amend *City of Coquitlam Zoning Bylaw No. 3000, 1996* in order to implement housekeeping changes to the Zoning Bylaw to improve overall clarity and administration of the Zoning Bylaw – *Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 5345, 2023*.

If approved, the City of Coquitlam Zoning Bylaw No. 3000, 1996 will be amended, and will generally include:

- Minor text and formatting amendments to fix typos or reference errors;
- Minor revisions to the uses, site regulations and location of uses in specific zones;
- Modernize definitions and regulations to support current planning best practices and development trends;
- Review regulations to address inconsistencies with other legislation including the Local Government Act and the BC Building Code.
