## Adopt-A-Street Program Agreement Form

The **Adopter** agrees to:

- 1. Remove litter from their designated section of Municipal property at least once a month for a minimum of a 1 year period, and provide a participant record for detailing efforts.
- 2. Take all precautions to ensure the safety and health of the adoptee and his/her group.
- 3. Ensure that appropriate tools and equipment are used during clean up and avoid direct contact with items that have the potential to be hazardous. Items such as syringes, needles, condoms and animal parts shall not be touched.
- 4. Immediately report hazardous litter and exceptionally heavy objects to the Adopt-A-Street Coordinator.
- 5. The adoptee and his/her group understand that at no time is the safety of any volunteer to be compromised in the performance of cleaning activities.
- 6. Accept training in order to provide quality service.
- 7. Treat with courtesy each individual with whom he/she comes into contact.
- 8. Obey all laws and regulations while volunteering for the City.

## The City of Coquitlam agrees to:

- 1. Supply operating supplies: e.g. Litter bags, gloves, safety vests and litter pickers, and make arrangements for free removal and disposal of litter collected by the volunteers from the designated street.
- 2. Provide third party liability insurance for injury to third parties and property damage arising out of the activities of this program. (Such insurance does not cover any loss suffered by participants in the program.)
- 3. Furnish and install two Adopt-A-Street signs with the Adopter's name on each sign.
