Notice of Zoning Amendment Bylaw for First, Second and Third Readings – 911 Delestre Avenue – Bylaw No. 5518, 2026

Notice is hereby given that the City of Coquitlam has received an application to amend *City of Coquitlam Zoning Bylaw No. 3000, 1996* relating to the property located at 911 Delestre Avenue.

The amending Bylaw (No. 5518, 2026) will be presented for first, second and third readings at the Regular Council Meeting on **Monday, July 6, 2026** at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, located at 3000 Guildford Way, Coquitlam, BC.

The intent of Bylaw No. 5518, 2026 is to amend *City of Coquitlam Zoning Bylaw No. 3000, 1996* to rezone subject property as outlined in black on the map marked “Schedule ‘A’ to Bylaw 5518, 2026” from R-1 Small-Scale Residential to R-4 Intensive Small-Scale Residential Zone.

If approved, the application would facilitate the development of eight multi-residential units within two buildings.

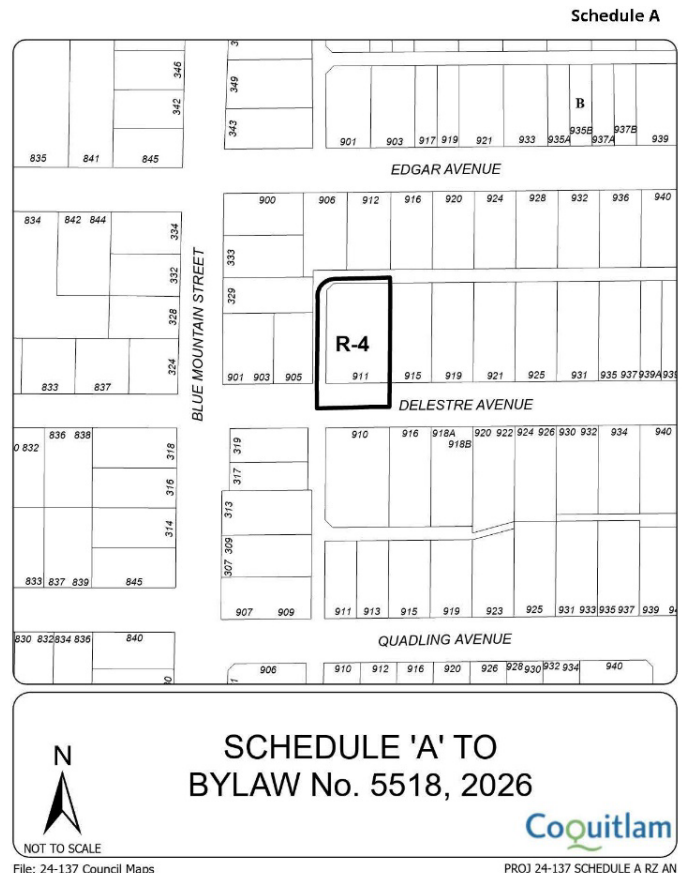
