CIVIC ADDRESSING BYLAW NO. 4476, 2022

On July 5th, 2022, City of Coquitlam Council Adopted *Civic Addressing Bylaw No. 4476, 2022*.

This bylaw will promote the City's goals of creating 'Safe and Complete Neighbourhoods' and 'Excellence in City Governance', in addition to a strategic multi-disciplinary approach aimed at public safety and the efficient identification and location of properties and businesses.

The bylaw can be summarized by the following key points:

- delegates authority to the City of Coquitlam to consistently and efficiently generate and assign new property addresses;
- outlines a formal set of regulations for assigning new addresses to complex buildings;
- provides consistent guidelines and a comprehensive addressing system that aligns closely with Fire and Rescue Services and other key outside agencies.

Effective July 5, 2022 all new construction of single family, duplex, triplex and fourplex buildings, that will have lane access are required to post the property address twice – one at the front of the building and one facing the rear lane. The address can be attached to any rear yard feature, (garage, fence, wall etc.) provided the number is clearly visible from the lane.

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
